### **Caprifoliaceae (Honeysuckle)**

*Nomenclature:* Royal Hort. Society

**Type** Shrub  
**Hardy range** 5B to 9A  
**Height** 5' to 6' / 1.60m to 1.80m  
**Spread** 6' to 7' / 1.80m to 2.20m  
**Growth rate** Average  
**Form** Rounded  
**Exposure** Partial shade or partial sun to full sun  
**Persistence** Semi-evergreen

**Bloom Color** Lavender  
**Bloom Time** Spring through Fall

The flowers are fragrant and showy.

### **Environment**

This plant tolerates some drought and some salt.

This plant will grow in dry soil.

Suitable soil is well-drained/loamy, sandy or clay.

The pH preference is an acidic to slightly alkaline (less than 6.8 to 7.7) soil.
